## SEPTEMBER MEETING PRESENTATION

## **Transmitter Hunting and Directional Antennas**

#### Presented by John Kludt, K7SYS

The program for the September meeting of the Bonner County Amateur Radio Club will focus on the basics of hidden transmitter hunting. Besides being just plain fun, hidden transmitter hunting is a skill with practical applications. Maybe you want to find the station stuck "key down" on the input of a local repeater. Perhaps a friend is lost in the woods but has an HT and can make a transmission from time to time. It sure would be nice to know how to located that individual using transmitter hunting skills. We will cover the basics focusing primarily on "walking T-hunting." The alternative is T-hunting from a car and we will talk a little bit about that as well.

To successfully locate a hidden transmitter a directional antenna is needed. We will be going over two factors that make a direction antenna important for transmitter hunting – antenna patterns and the concept of gain. Pattern and gain make a directional antenna useful in many other circumstances and we will cover some of them as part of the discussion.
